Our University Foundation Course is a cost-effective and inspiring route to university, designed especially for ambitious students aged 16½ and over who are ready to take the next step in their academic journey.

Taught by expert, caring staff in small classes, the course combines rigorous subject teaching with personalised tutor support. You'll benefit from individual attention, regular progress tracking, and tailored guidance to help you reach your full potential — academically and personally.

Accredited by **NCFE** and internally assessed, our Foundation Course offers flexible start dates and pathways to suit every learner:

- **18-month course:** January start
- **1-year course:** September start
- **6-month fast track:** January start
- **2-year course:** September start

With **IELTS preparation built in**, you'll gain the language confidence and academic grounding needed for success at leading universities worldwide.

Program Overview

Our Foundation Courses are organised into three broad pathways: **Art, Science, and Humanities**. Within these, you can choose from a range of specialised programmes that define your academic focus and future direction.

You will study at least three subjects, carefully selected to support university goals. Options include core subjects such as **Mathematics, Chemistry, and Psychology**, alongside a wide choice of complementary courses within each pathway.

The **Psychology** programme can be approached from either a *scientific* or *humanities* perspective, allowing you to tailor your learning to your interests and ambitions.

Quality Assured Learning

NCFE ACCREDITATION

Our University Foundation Courses are fully **accredited by NCFE**, an awarding organisation recognised by the qualification regulators for England and Wales — Ofqual (England) and the Welsh Government (Wales). Each Foundation Course at St Andrew's is delivered under our **NCFE Customised Qualifications Licence**, ensuring that every programme meets the highest standards of academic quality and assessment integrity.

ASSESSMENT

Designed to support progress and build confidence throughout the course. You'll be evaluated **monthly** using a variety of methods, including written assignments, practical assessments, and exams. In **December**, you'll sit an exam in each core subject to gauge your performance so far. Following this, you'll meet individually with your tutor to review results and, where helpful, develop a personalised **Individual Learning Plan (ILP)**.

During the **spring term**, you'll complete **six practical assessments**, which together account for **40%** of your final mark. **Final examinations**, held in the penultimate week of the course, include two papers per core subject (two hours each) and contribute **60%** of the overall grade.

AWARDS

On successful completion of the programme, you'll receive a **Level 3 Diploma** certificate and a full transcript of results from both **St. Andrew's College Cambridge** and **NCFE**.

Final awards are classified as follows:

- **Fail/Resubmit:** 0–49%
- **Pass:** 50–59%
- **Merit:** 60–69%
- **Distinction:** 70–79%
- **Distinction with Honours:** 80% and above
